Zoe enjoys telling stories and playing doctor. She also loves to sing and make music. Reading is one of her

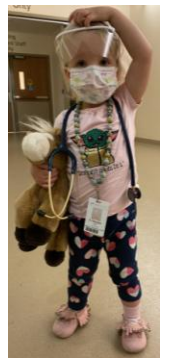
